


HUMAN CAPITAL & DEVELOPMENT

- PHP supports flexible working and working from home, with a number of employees able to work full time for the company whilst living in locations such as Bath, Yorkshire and Ireland.
- PHP has recently supported 6 staff in obtaining their professional qualifications whilst at the company (RICS, IMA and ACCA), providing time for exam leave and contributions to the cost of courses.
- Every employee receives a semi-annual performance review, with clear goals and targets set, feedback given and training and development plans.
- Employees can participate in a voluntary Investment Savings Account, managed by Equiniti and provided by PHP, to acquire shares in PHP PLC.

- PHP has supported its employees with event sponsorship for a number of charities over 2019, including:
 - 200 mile bike ride from Bristol to Cambridge in aid for Parkinsons UK
 - In aid of Back Up, a charity supporting people that have suffered a spinal cord injury, participating in teams to conquer Snowdon (3,500 ft), one member of which is a wheelchair user being pushed, pulled, wheeled and carried over the 8 mile long path to the summit.
